## DEN CHIEF TRAINING

**WHAT IS A DEN CHIEF?** An older Boy Scout, Varsity Scout or Venturer who serves as a leadership and activities assistant to a Cub Scout den or Webelos patrol. A den chief is a leadership position that can be used towards rank advancement, and a position that provides many opportunities for direct utilization of leadership, responsibility, communication and organizational skills.

**QUALIFICATIONS:** This *training* may be taken by Scouts of any age/rank. It is recommended that before taking on the den chief position a Scout speaks with their Scout leader about their interest in the position and obtains the leader's support and approval.

**COURSE DESCRIPTION:** This training instructs Scouts on the den chief leadership position and the necessary skills to lead and work with Tiger, Cub and Webelos Scouts. The course motivates through fun, hands on learning skills, and the playing of games and activities that will help the Scouts understand their role in the Cub Scout den and pack.
